## Privacy Policy

World Titanium Resources Limited (the "Company") believes that privacy is an important individual right and is important to our own business and the businesses of our clients.

In this policy we set out the standards to which the Company is committed in ensuring the privacy of individuals. We are also bound to comply with the National Privacy Principles as set out in the Privacy Act 1988.

### Collection of Personal Information

The Company only collects personal information if it is necessary for our business purposes. Personal information is information that individually identifies you, such as your name, telephone number, physical address, or email address. The information we collect will depend on the purpose for which it is collected – it may be limited to contact details where we interact with the public (eg through the Company's website) or it may include more detailed information where a client relationship exists.

### Use of Personal Information

We generally use personal information for the primary purpose for which it is collected. That may include supplying our products or responding to an individual's request.

Depending on the purpose for which we have collected personal information, we may store some of the information in our Company's records. Some or all of this information may be available to partners and authorised staff of the Company for use in accordance with this policy.

Internally, we have controls and procedures to ensure that personal information provided to us remains confidential. All of our staff are trained in privacy and are bound by strict duties of confidentiality to the Company and its clients.

We will not collect or use personal information in ways other than as stated in this policy unless we have obtained an individual's consent. In some cases we may specifically request a consent form to be signed. In other cases, consent may be implied (for instance, where an individual gives us information after being fully advised of how it will be used).

### Disclosure of Personal Information

We do not sell or trade personal information, or allow third parties to use that personal information for their own purposes.

If information needs to be accessed by a third party, we attempt to limit that access to the extent necessary for the third party to provide services to us or to perform its functions. We will ensure that those suppliers and contractors are also bound by duties of confidentiality and by the same privacy obligations as the Company itself.

In all other cases, we will only disclose personal information to a third party if the disclosure is permitted or required by law (including under the National Privacy Principles), including:

To protect and defend the rights or property of the Company; or

To identify persons who may be violating the law, the Company's legal notice and any web site user agreement, the rights of third parties, or otherwise misusing the Company website.

The Company uses reasonable precautions to keep the information disclosed to us secure. The Company reserves the right to transfer all such information in connection with the sale of all or part of the Company's capital stock or assets.

The Company will not be responsible for unauthorized access to its computer and network systems nor for the disclosure or destruction of personal information. When disclosing personal information to third parties the Company shall require the third party to limit its storage, use and disclosure of personal information to the purpose that the information was disclosed.

### **Privacy on our Website**

This policy applies equally to any personal information we collect via our website. Apart from personal information you provide to us intentionally (eg. where you make a request or complete a registration form), this section explains some other ways in which the Company collects information via its website.

In general, you can visit the Company's website without providing personal information, but there may be times when we will request personal information. This information may be requested when you wish to download product information. We may also gather personal information in connection with event registrations or subscriptions to newsletters and other information bulletins.

The Company may from time to time provide links to websites operated by third parties. You should be aware that we are not responsible for the privacy practices or policies of those sites. We encourage you to review each website's privacy policy, especially if you intend to disclose any personal information via that site. A link to a third party website is not an express or implied endorsement, promotion or warranty of the products or services offered by or accessible through that site or advertised on that site.

In some situations we may also collect information when you visit our web site through the use of "cookie" technology. The information gathered may include your log-on and password (if applicable) for the Company's website, IP address, region, the type of browser and operating system you are using, the domain name of your internet service provider and site visitation statistics.

Information collected through the use of cookies is used to evaluate and improve our website and to help diagnose problems with our server. Cookies also help us to deliver content specific to your interests and allow us to save your password so you don't have to re-enter it each time you visit our site.

### **Security of Personal Information**

The Company aims to achieve industry best practice in the security of personal information which it holds. It is our policy to destroy personal information once there is no longer a legal or business need for us to retain it.

### **Access to Information**

We will provide access to personal information upon request by an individual, unless a request is unreasonable and the National Privacy Principles would permit us to decline that access (for instance, where granting access would infringe another person's privacy).

Clients who wish to gain access to their personal information should contact the Company using the contact details set out in our website.

When you make a request to access personal information, we will require you to provide some form of identification (eg. driver's licence or passport) so we can verify that you are the person to whom the information relates. In some cases we may also request an administrative fee to cover the cost of access.

### **Corrections and Concerns**

If you believe that information we hold about you is incorrect, or if you have concerns about how we are handling your personal information then we ask that you contact us and we will try to resolve those concerns.

**Effect of Policy**

This policy does not form a contract between an individual and the Company. The policy may also be subject to change. Whenever you need to refer to this policy you should contact us, or check our website, for the most up to date version.

**Review**

The Policy will be reviewed as required and at least annually. Any amendments to the Policy will require approval from the Board.
